






BAYLANDS GOLF LINKS | A YOUNG FORREST RICHARDSON WITH A SCALE MODEL OF PAPAGO GC






LINKS AT LAS PALOMAS. L. FORREST RICHARDSON, 75TH PRESIDENT OF THE ASGCA

Our lineage begins with Henry Fownes, founder of America's iconic Oakmont Country Club.

In 1907 a young Arthur Snyder began caddying for Fownes, eventually joining the grounds crew to build many of Oakmont's famous bunkers. Arthur's son, Jack Snyder, studied landscape architecture, becoming the 38th member of the American Society of Golf Course Architects. Jack was Forrest's mentor.

Today we draw from the innovation of Fownes, yet with an eye toward the future. Forrest became the 200th member of ASGCA and eventually served as its 75th President.








